DID YOU KNOW?

The bumblebee is easily identified by its hairy abdomen. It can be up to one inch in length and is usually black with yellow stripes on the thorax and abdomen.

As social insects, bumblebees live in colonies in old rodent burrows, or other cavities within the ground. Occasionally, bumblebees will establish a nest above ground in a wall, firewood pile, shed, crawl space or attic.

> The workers of the colony forage on pollen and nectar for food. They also produce honey, but it is not edible for humans. The bees will attack and sting to defend their nest, so they are considered a health concern.
